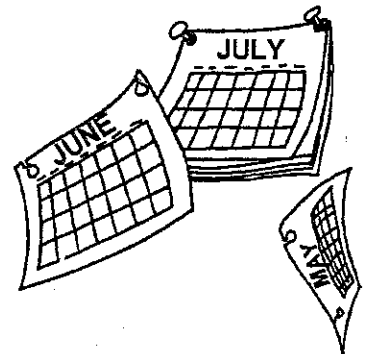
Example: July 20, 1981
